- 3-Digit Addition Work Page



Open Syllables	Closed Syllables
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. This syllable has only one vowel.</li><li>2. The vowel is the last letter in the syllable.</li><li>3. The vowel makes it's long sound.</li></ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. This syllable has 1 vowel.</li><li>2. The vowel is followed by one or more consonants</li></ol>
