### PHASES OF THE MOON DEFINITION

The portion of the moon that we can see from Earth on any given night is called the moon's phase. As the moon orbits around the Earth, sunlight is reflected off the moon's surface and that light reaches us on Earth. The phase of the moon depends on where the moon is in its orbit. It takes about 28 days for the moon to make a full orbit around the Earth, meaning the phases of the moon repeat about once a month!

# Tomochichi

Tomochichi was a chief of a Creek Indian village that was located near Savannah, Georgia. Tomochichi must have been a great hunter and warrior to become chief of a village. In 1733, a general came near Tomochichi's village and wanted to start a colony there. This general was James Oglethorpe who is credited with the founding of Savannah and the colony of Georgia. Tomochichi wanted to be friendly with these new settlers so he welcomed them and allowed them to settle there. Tomochichi encouraged trading with the settlers and with the help of Mary Musgrove who translated Creek and English, helped his tribe to flourish and helped the English defend themselves against the Spanish soldiers in the south. Tomochichi traveled to England with James Oglethorpe when he was 90 years old. He was very popular there and even met the royal family. Tomochichi also was able to found a school for his tribe. Tomochichi and James Oglethorpe worked together to achieve peace and goodwill for the neighboring colonies. Tomochichi lived into his 90's and when he died was given a military funeral by the English. Tomochichi is best known for being a good mediator and helping two cultures coexist together. If not for him, our state of Georgia might be quite different today.
